THE GRAND JURY CHARGES:

COUNT ONE

**Title 18, United States Code, Section 2251
Sexual Exploitation of Children**

From on or about November or December 2003, in the District of Puerto Rico and elsewhere within the jurisdiction of this Court,

JOSE CARRION VAZQUEZ,

the defendant herein, used, persuaded, induced, enticed or coerced a female minor, that is, a person under the age of 18 years of age, to engage in sexually explicit conduct for the purpose of producing a visual depiction of such conduct, to wit: José Carrión Vázquez used, persuaded, induced, enticed, or coerced a female minor under the age of 12 to engage in simulated vaginal and anal sex as well as actual oral sex, and the lascivious exhibition of her genitals, while the female minor was blindfolded. The defendant José Carrión Vázquez engaged in said sexual activity with the female minor for the purpose of producing a visual depiction of said conduct.

Said visual depictions were produced using materials that had been mailed, shipped, or transported in interstate or foreign commerce by any means. All in violation of Title 18, United States Code, Section 2251(a).

COUNT TWO

**Title 18, United States Code, Section 2252(a)
Certain Activities Relating to Material Involving
Sexual Exploitation of Children**

On or about December 2003, in the District of Puerto Rico and elsewhere within the jurisdiction of this Court,

JOSE CARRION VAZQUEZ,

the defendant herein, did knowingly possess one or more films, video tapes, or other matter which contained visual depictions of a female minor, that is, a person under the age of eighteen (18), engaging in sexually explicit conduct, to wit, the lascivious exhibition of the genitals of said minor as well as the adult male engaging in various actual and simulated sexual acts including, masturbation, oral and partial vaginal penetration. Said visual depictions were produced using materials which have been mailed or shipped or transported in interstate or foreign commerce by any means, in violation of Title 18, United States Code, Section 2252(a)(4)(B).




