- Step on — dilute drugs
- Strawberry — female who trades sex for crack or money to buy crack
- Taste — small sample of drugs
- Taxing — charging more per vial depending on race of customer or if not a regular customer
- Thoroughbred — drug dealer who sells pure narcotics
- Toss-up — females who trades sex for crack or money to buy crack
- Tout — person who introduces buyers to sellers
- Turf — place where drugs are sold
- Uncle — Federal agents
- Wasted — under the influence of drugs; murdered
- Working — selling crack
- Zoomer — individual who sells fake crack and then flees
