Course Description:

This is a five day comprehensive and introductory course designed to provide health care professionals with the skills to complete an assessment, evaluation, treatment, evidence recognition, collection, and courtroom testimony for the pediatric sexual assault/abuse patient.

It will be highly beneficial if the participant has previously completed an Adult/Adolescent Training Course.

Objectives:

- Identify the benefit of the multi-disciplinary approach to child sexual assault cases
- Identify issues and methodology surrounding child sexual assault
- Discuss laws specific to the protection of children reporting sexual abuse
- Demonstrate child history-taking with a non-leading question technique
- Review the stages of pediatric growth and development
- Discuss the various examination positions for evaluation of sexual abuse in the prepubescent child.
- Discuss STD recognition and treatment in the pediatric population
- Discuss appropriate interpretation of prepubescent genital findings of the child
- Discuss interpretation of hymenal variations and abnormalities in the child
- Discuss evaluation and interpretation of anal abnormalities in the child
- Discuss conditions mistaken for abuse
- Recognize the value of the use of a colposcope when examining children
- Recognize the need for evidence collection
- Review courtroom strategies in child sexual assault cases
