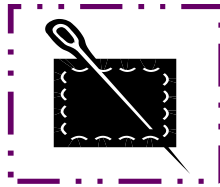

*(Perhaps we can get Elaine to open her home for Tea again at the October Hog Roast?)*

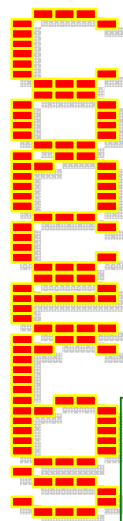
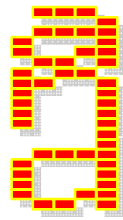
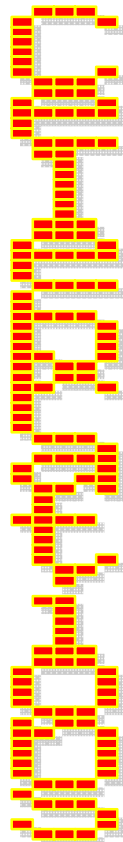
