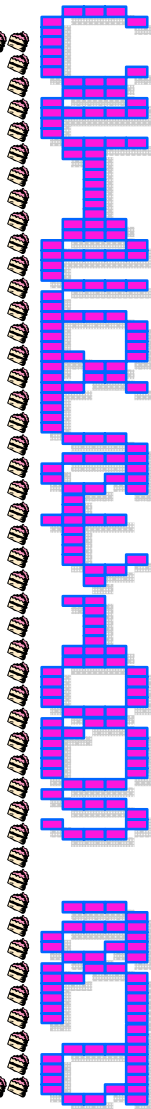
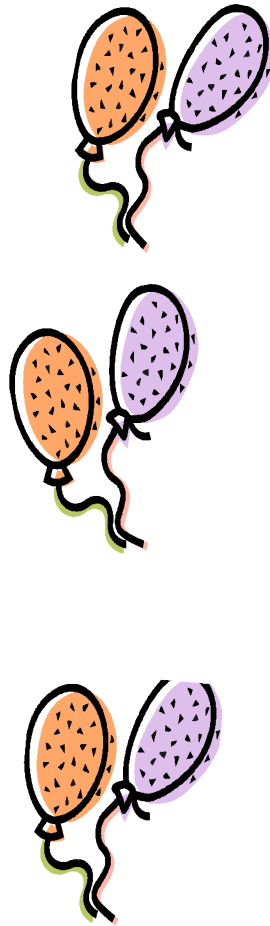
WISH Mystery Trip Coming Soon!

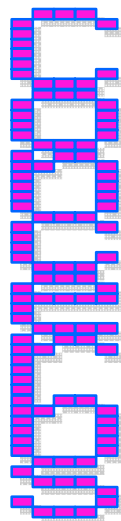

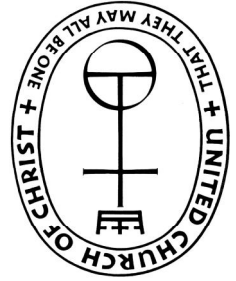
