Well it's that time again already. It's so hard to believe that summer is coming to a close and fall will shortly be upon us. We are planning a few new exciting changes to our Children's Church.

First we will be adding a music component to our weekly Children's Church service. We are taking over the third classroom space downstairs and converting it into a music and worship area for the kids. We will start our service with a contemporary Christian worship

song and then bring in an old favorite or two (The B-I-B-L-E, Zacchaeus, Deep and Wide, etc).

Then we will have a "Mission Moment" which will usually be dedicated to Heifer International, our main project this year. We will move from that to the story for the week and then the kids will go with their age group class to participate in an activity to help reinforce the story. These activities will change each week and will include cooking, art, science projects, writing activities, games, etc.

Second, we are adding a nursery/preschool component! The nursery kids will be joining us all during the 10:30 worship service just like the elementary kids do. They will get to participate in Reverend Ed's Children's Message each week and then go downstairs with the "big kids" so we can all begin the Children's Church worship together. Then they will go up to the nursery with their weekly teacher to complete a sticker page activity and/or a coloring page and of course some play time! Don't let this change scare anyone away from signing up for nursery duty. It should actually be easier and more meaningful for everyone. All the materials are copied and ready to go for you so come have fun with the kids and help foster a love for God!
