Come join us for a Road Trip on Route 254 - Psalm 25:4 – *“Show me your ways, O Lord, teach me your paths;...”*

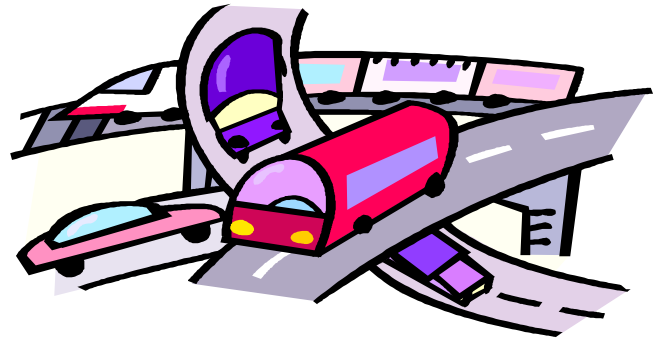
The RV is packed and ready!
