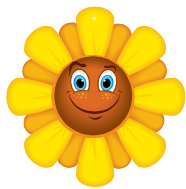

The Missions Ministry dedicates May to the Center for New Beginnings, a shelter for battered women and their children.

(Services include, Emergency Housing, Transitional Housing, 24-Hour Crisis Phone Line, Victim and Child advocate Programs, Support Groups, Community Education, Counseling, and Case Management Services.)

"The shelter can always use donations of canned and packaged food such as tuna, spaghetti sauce, spaghetti, macaroni cheese, ramen noodles, soup, etc.

This month the most urgent needs are:

- ◆ Coffee Creamer
- ◆ Sugar
- ◆ Coffee
- ◆ Cereals for children
- ◆ Snacks for children (crackers, fruit roll ups, cookies, juice boxes)
- ◆ Paper products – Kleenex, toilet tissue, paper towels
- ◆ Cleaning supplies - bleach, disinfectant wipes, pinesol, air fresheners
- ◆ Dryer sheets
- ◆ Laundry detergent
- ◆ Dishwasher detergent
- ◆ Body wash
- ◆ Alarm clocks



Money is also very appreciated. The director indicated that they could also use a bagless vacuum cleaner and/or a DVD player or two. Any money collected will go toward purchase of these items.

Food pantry items are always welcomed and a collection container is located in the Narthex. However, it would be great if everyone could remember to bring an item to be collected on the last Sunday of each month. Items currently needed include Personal Items, Ramen Noodles, Jelly, Paper Products, and Large Family Size jars are wonderful. Also, gently used items of leisure such as puzzles, and magazines are welcomed and enjoyed.

Also, we continue to collect 'change for change'. A jar is located in the Narthex. Please consider dropping some pocket change into the jar. Missions will allocate the collection to coordinate with the church's current missions project.
