

## LSA MEETING MINUTES – MONDAY, OCTOBER 10, 2011

- The meeting came to order at 6:30p.m. with the Pledge of Allegiance. 18 members were present.
- **Principal's Comments**
  - Mr. Miller spoke about the new Stop, Walk and Listen program being implemented through the whole school. He spoke directly to the 3<sup>rd</sup> – 5<sup>th</sup> graders and sent a letter out to all parents.
  - Mr. Miller said that Mr. Rich VanPelt is running unopposed for the upcoming Leroy Trustee election but you should still be aware of what issues he supports as well as all the candidates who are running for the 2 School Board openings. He has phone numbers available if you wish.
- **Secretary's Report**
  - Leslie Ferus made a motion to approve September minutes, 2<sup>nd</sup> by April Kovalchuk. All were in agreement.
  - LSA Membership Drive was successful. Mrs. Vernick's class won the drive and memberships are now in excess of what they were last year.
- **Treasury Report**
  - Amy went over the budget as it stands so far this year. No issues were raised.
  - Amy spoke about the upcoming fundraiser at Chip's Fun House. This is a mini golf course in Chardon and it will be held on Friday, October 14<sup>th</sup> from 11a till 9p. No flyer needed just say you are from Leroy. What their website for closings due to rain – rain date will be Saturday.

  - *Rigatoni Dinner* – Tina Witt is coordinating this year again – Thank you Tina! Date is Nov. 4<sup>th</sup> and times are 5p-7p. There will be one ticket price with kids having the option of splitting a dinner. She will need about 6 people to help with serving and such. Tickets will be available to purchase from the office starting Oct. 24<sup>th</sup>. Look for more information to come home.
- **President's Report**
  - *Restaurant Fundraiser* – CiCi's will be on Friday, Nov. 18<sup>th</sup> from 4p-9p. No flyer needed. Just let them know you are from Leroy. CiCi's will also post a sign as a reminder.
