PULL-APART COFFEE CAKE

Place 1 sm pkg frozen bread dough balls into greased bundt pan.
Sprinkle 1 sm box BUTTERSCOTCH PUDDING (NOT instant) over dough balls.

In sm saucepan combine:
1 stick butter (melt)
½ c chopped pecans
¾ c brown sugar
¼ tsp cinnamon

Pour mixture over dough. Cover with waxed paper & let set out overnight (or till doubled size) to rise.
Bake at 350 approx 30 minutes.
