## Hearty Eight-Layer Salad

1 ½ c. uncooked small shell macaroni,  
3 c. shredded lettuce, 1/8 tsp pepper, 1 c julienned hard salami, 1 c mayonnaise, ¼ c chopped green onions, 1 c shredded Colby or Monterey Jack cheese, 1 tbs vegetable oil, 3 hard boiled eggs sliced, ¼ tsp salt, 1 c julienned cooked ham, 1 pkg frozen peas thawed, ¼ c sour cream, 1 tsp Dijon mustard

Cook macaroni according to pkg directions, rinse w/cold water. Drizzle w/oil, toss to coat, Place lettuce in 2 ½ qt glass serving bowl, top with macaroni and eggs. Sprinkle with salt and pepper. Layer with ham, salami and peas. Combine mayonnaise, sour cream, green onions and mustard. Spread over top, cover and refrigerate for several hours or overnight. Just before serving, sprinkle with cheese
