Can't come with your Den or Pack? Come as **Provisional Campers!** We'll match your boy up with a top notch adult leader. All the joys of camp and new friends too!

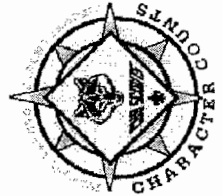


Cub Days

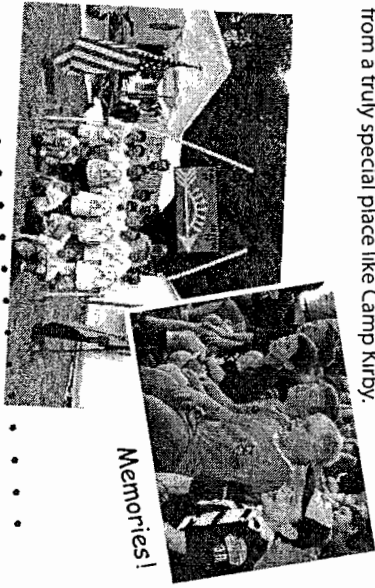

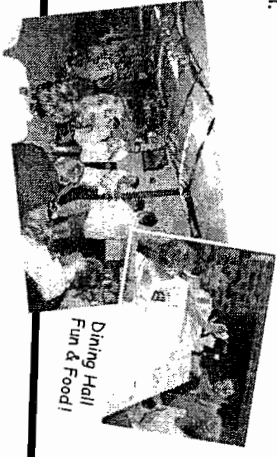

Water Slide!

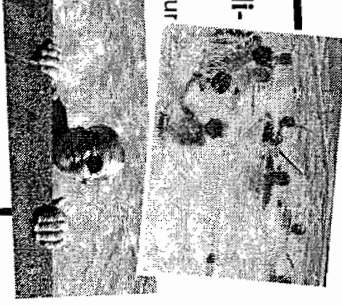

can't be duplicated by your pack on its own. Camp Kirby's camping facilities are fully accredited and just packed with fun.

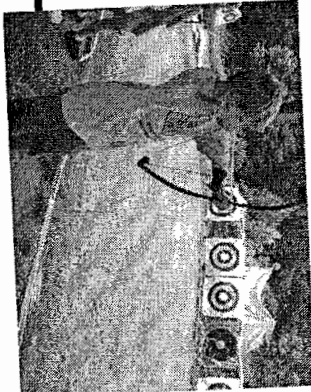


Swim!

Whether you are sitting down to a nutritious hot meal, playing water polo, or lining up a bull's eye, our facilities are classic Scout Camp. Following a mandatory swimming skill test, campers can cool off in our 8 foot deep pool. Safety is the watch word at our newly roofed target shooting range where Cubs can try their hand at archery (all camping) or BBs (3 and 6 day camping only). After a busy day, campers sleep the night away on comfy cots in our spacious 7 person platform tents. Our hot showers and flush toilets are complemented with hand washing stations and conveniently located porta-potties. Kirby also boasts a campfire amphitheater, handicraft lodge, and a Trading Post stocked with everything from snacks to Scouting paraphernalia.
