See the website for the results of the Pinewood derby and photos of each den's cars.

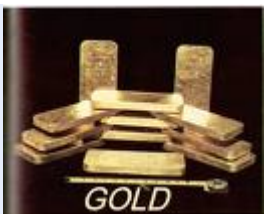

Camp Kirby- Early Discount – Due by Sat. Mar 25th.

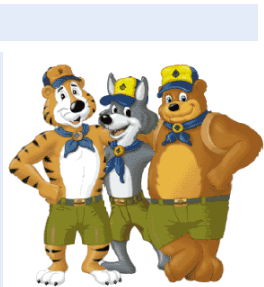
