Ministries

2009 marked many firsts. The first CLM Seminars were held at Wildwood Chapel in Aliquippa. Each of them was very well attended.

James Shipley was brought on as CLM's first fully functioning Associate. He has really moved his SKILLS ministry forward, and we look with anticipation towards

what God will accomplish through him in 2009.

The coaching ministry was also established in 2009, with eight ministers receiving one-on-one coaching from the executive director.

2008 Income

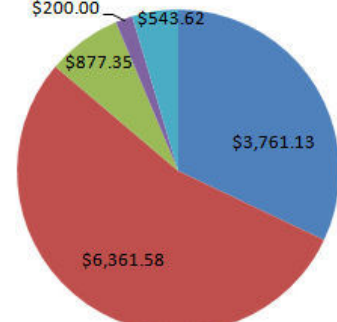
■ Coaching ■ Churches ■ Individuals
