Daniel G. Reiff, 87, of New Cumberland, PA, passed away on Wednesday, January 18, 2012, at home. He was born in New Cumberland on February 13, 1924, to the late Robert Vincent Reiff, Sr. and Grace E. (Garver) Reiff-Greenawalt. Dan graduated from New Cumberland High School with the Class of 1942. He was a World War II U.S. Army Air Corps veteran, surviving at least 28 missions over Germany and France in a B-24 bomber. He retired in 1986 as a systems analyst from the USASAC division at the New Cumberland Army Depot after 40 years of service.

Bowl and ABC West over many decades and through 2011.
