NARFE is an organization governed by an elected leadership consisting of 1,477 chapters; 50 state federations, plus the District of Columbia, Panama, the Philippines and Puerto Rico. NARFE members represent a broad spectrum of government services. Most are covered by the Civil Service Retirement System (CSRS) or the Federal Employees Retirement System (FERS). Some members, however, receive retirement benefits from independent agency plans such as the Foreign Service Retirement System, Tennessee Valley Authority Retirement System, Federal Judiciary Retirement System, Central Intelligence Agency Retirement System and more than 40 others.

Who Can Join?

Membership is open to civilians who are or will be eligible to receive an annuity or survivor annuity from the federal retirement programs of any agency of the United States government, and the District of Columbia*, including:

- Retirees
- Active employees
- Spouses and surviving spouses of those eligible to join NARFE
- Former employees
- A former spouse who is legally entitled to a federal survivor annuity.

When you enroll in NARFE, you join the National Association and a chapter closest to your area of residence or another chapter of your choice. You may transfer to a different chapter at any time.
