WHAT IS THE JAMBOREE?

The National Jamboree is Scouting's grandest tradition—a gathering of Scouts and leaders from across the nation, as well as a contingent of Scouts from overseas. The Jamboree is a showcase for the Scouting movement. The 10-day event is packed full of activities...everything from snorkeling; to rappelling; to mountain bike/rifle courses; to climbing through an Army Abrams tank; to canoeing; to merit badges; to fishing; to conservation; to pioneering; to daily stage shows; to the Conservation Nature Trail; and even hosting your own radio show on Jamboree radio QBSA 95.1 , “*The Voice of the Eagle*” !

Join 35,000 other Scouts at the 2010 National Scout Jamboree to celebrate BSA's birthday. The Jamboree will be the pinnacle of BSA's 100th anniversary celebration, and will be held at Fort A.P Hill, in Caroline County, near Bowling Green, VA, about 60 miles south of Washington, D.C.

TRAVEL PLANS:

The Council jamboree contingent will leave Allentown on Saturday, July 24, 2010 approximately 6 am and travel by motor coach to Washington, D.C. We will spend two days and two nights touring the historic sites and points of interest in the area. We will be staying at the 4-H Youth Conference Center, located in Maryland on Connecticut Avenue, one mile north of Washington, D.C. While in Washington, D.C., ample time will be allowed to tour the Smithsonian Institution, the White House, and many more of the federal offices, such as the FBI and the Capitol. We will depart Washington, D.C. for the jamboree on Monday, July 26th, arriving at Fort A.P. Hill, Virginia just after lunch. We will camp at the Jamboree and depart on Wednesday morning, August 4th, and arrive back in Allentown approximately 6 pm that same evening.

Final payment -	\$ TBA	\$35 plus any contingency amount to cover unforeseen cost increases (ex: bus rentals, fuel, etc.) and due June, 2010
