NORTH VALLEY WEBELOS WINTER EVENT PROCEDURES

"TENT PITCHING"

Tent Pitching

Teams will hang a "tent" (tarp) between 2 trees with ropes. Prior knowledge of the following knots is helpful: 2 half hitches, tautline hitch, and clove hitch.

What To Bring

Lunch & Drinks for yourself

Bring enough for 2 stations

6x8 tarp One 25' rope & Four 4' ropes Four plastic tent stakes & mallet
(bring extra)

Stop watch or other watch to keep time with

How To Run Event

Set up 2 stations

Prior to starting, pick 2 trees to use to hang "tent" from

Do a trial set up to determine where stakes should go & leave them in ground for teams

Teams are to use 1 long rope and tie a clove hitch around each of the two trees and put "tent" (tarp) over it

4 short ropes are to fasten it to stakes

*2-half-hitches are to be tied at the corner grommets of the tarp

*Tautline Hitches are to be tied at the stakes

**Switch these two if desired since it's better to have the taut line away from the ground in bad weather*

Team members and leaders are allowed to verbally encourage their teams from at least 10 feet away

No physical assistance is to be given by anyone

"THREE MAN SNOWSHOE"

3 Man Snowshoe

3 boys from each team are to walk with "snowshoes" (2x6 boards) a specified distance.

What To Bring

Lunch & Drinks for yourself

(2) 1x6 boards 5' long each (cut notches for ropes in 3 spots on each side of boards)

6 ropes ~ 6' long each

Stop watch to keep time with

How To Run Event

3 boys (teams to chose which 3) are to walk at least 50 feet with the "snowshoes"

Team members and leaders are allowed to verbally encourage their teams but no physical assistance is to be given by anyone

" MAP READING"

Lashing

Teams will learn how to read a street map.

What To Bring

Lunch & Drinks for yourself
Maps & other supplies needed

How To Run Event

Teach how to read a street map. If more than one group is at station at the same time, have them all work for the full 1/2 hour.

"SCOUT LORE"

Scout Lore

Teams are given a written test on topics such as the Boy Scout Oath and Law and the Outdoor Code. All answers should be found in the Webelos Handbook. Leaders are to offer NO assistance to boys.

What To Bring

- Lunch & Drinks for yourself
- 30 copies of the test (Council will provide photocopies)
- 1 copy of answer sheet
- Pencils
- 2 clipboards

How To Run Event

- Put each team at different tables to take the test.
- The teams may NOT help each other
- Teams should pick one boy to do the actual writing

Instruct boys NOT to discuss test with any other team throughout the day. It gives an unfair advantage.

No one is allowed to assist them in any way. Leaders are not to be near tables when teams are taking test.

They have the entire time slot to finish test.

Leaders may request test at end of day.

Turn in Test for scoring!

Be sure to write total # **CORRECT** at top of page.

"ICE RESCUE"

Ice Rescue

Teams are to rescue a "drowning victim" by tying several short pieces of rope together to make one long piece. Prior knowledge of the following knots is helpful: Bowline (2), Square Knot (2) and Sheet Bend (2). (*Bowline will be used at both "victim" & "rescuer". Square knots & sheet bends will be used in the middle.*)

What To Bring

- Lunch & Drinks for yourself
- Small plastic round sled
- 2 pieces 3/8" rope 10' long
- Four pieces of 1/4" rope 5' long each
- Something for start & finish lines
- Watch to keep time with

How To Run Event

- Lay ropes in line, but not tied together (Fat ropes on each end with 3 thin between)
- One boy sits in sled and waits
- One boy ties bowline at far end of fat rope - but **does NOT** keep it around himself
- Two boys connect fat to thin ropes with sheet bends
- Two boys tie square knots to connect smaller ropes together
- When all the knots are tied, the now "longer" rope" is thrown to boy in sled
- Boy in sled ties bowline around himself and holds on to the sled
- The other 4 boys then pull him in the sled across the finish line "to safety"

- Team members and leaders are allowed to verbally encourage their teams
- No physical assistance is to be given by anyone
- If there is less than 6 boys, some will have to tie more than one knot
- *Teams have max of 12 minutes to complete event

- 1-5 with 5 being the highest

"COMPASS COURSE"

Compass Course

Teams will learn how to use a compass and follow a basic compass course.

What To Bring

Lunch & Drinks for yourself

Compasses (map style)

Flags and other supplies needed for basic compass course

How To Run Event

Set up a very basic compass course

Work with all boys at station (even if there are multiple teams)

Teach boys how to read a compass and find their way on the course
(keep in mind they are 9 & 10 year olds and only have 30 minutes)

"KLONDIKE DERBY SLED RACE"

Teams will be doing this station and Toxic Waste in the same timeslot. When team finishes, send them right over to Toxic Waste station.

Klondike Sled Race

Teams will pull a Klondike Derby Sled a specified distance.

What To Bring

Lunch & Drinks for yourself
Your Troop's Klondike Derby Sled

How To Run Event

Teams are to have up to 5 boys pulling and 1 boy pushing the sled
The course is to go a straight run of approx. 50 feet
Have teams run sled twice
Team members and leaders are allowed to verbally encourage their teams
No physical assistance is to be given by anyone
When team finishes, send them right over to Toxic Waste station
(They'll do both stations in the same time slot)

NORTH VALLEY WEBELOS WINTER EVENT PROCEDURES

"TOXIC WASTE DISPOSAL"

- *Teams will come to this station directly from the Sled Race during same time slot*
- *Time will NOT be scored*
- *If a team has less than 6 boys, Den Chiefs or adult leaders MAY assist them*

Toxic Waste Disposal

Teams are to move a can of "toxic waste" (water, snow, sand, etc.) from one point to another by using several long ropes and bungee cords.

What To Bring

Lunch & Drinks for yourself

2 large coffee cans

Bungies and Ropes for "bungee set up" (ask someone's who's done it before for specifics)

5 gallons of water (or something to add weight in can)

Stop watch or other watch to keep time with

How To Run Event

Set up 2 stations

Fill cans with water or something appropriate

Put "bungee setup" around cans with enough ropes for one per boy (up to 6)

Teams are to use "bungee setup" to move can full of water from one circle to the other - without spilling the water. They must start over if the water spills.

Time ends when the can is within the second circle.

Team members and leaders are allowed to verbally encourage their teams

There may be 2 teams at station during each 30- minute time slot (12 boys at a time), try to have something that can accommodate all of them

"BASIC FIRST AID "

Basic First Aid

Teams will learn basic first aid skills required for Readyman (requirements # 3,4 and 5)

How To Run Your Station

Teach basic first aid skills required for #3,4 and 5 of the Webelos Readyman achievement.

#3 Show what to do for these hurry cases:

- Serious bleeding
- Stopped breathing
- Internal poisoning
- Heart attack

#4 Show how to treat shock

#5 Show first aid for the following

- Cuts and scratches
- Burns & scalds
- Choking

If more than one group is at the station, work with them all together.

** When teaching them... remember they are 4th and 5th graders - don't get too technical!*

" LASHING "

Lashing

Teams will learn basic lashing skills.

What To Bring

- Lunch & Drinks for yourself
- Enough poles & ropes for 4 groups to lash
 - Poles/branches 2 inch thick x 6 feet long
 - Poles/branches 4 inch thick x 6 feet long
 - Ropes enough to lash poles together

How To Run Event

Teach basic Round Lashing and/or Square Lashing techniques - Have boys work in small groups. If more than one group is at station at the same time, have them all work for the full ½ hour.
