

LEGRAND REYNOLDS HORSEMAN'S AREA

The LeGrand Horseman's Area is operated as a co-operative effort between the R.I. Department of Environmental Management and the R.I. Federation of Riding Clubs.

USE GUIDELINES

- This is a carry in / carry out area. There is no trash pickup. Your co-operation is appreciated.
- Camping without horses is prohibited.
- Dogs are to be leashed at all times at the Horseman's Area.
- All users will clean up manure and place in bins provided.
- Day users park around ring, not in campsites. No camping permitted around ring.
- All vehicles keep speed limit of 10 mph in the Horseman's Area.
- Horses or camping are not permitted within 50 feet of wells, within the enclosure of the well area, or the enclosed fireplace area.
- The camping fee is \$3.00 per site per night with a maximum stay of 4 nights unless extended by special permission. (call 401-539-2356 for permission)
- When a group permit is in force, D.E.M. will authorize a representative of that group who will issue camping permits and collect fees from all users. Permits must be posted on windshield of car.
- Please mail the appropriate fee to Jay B.Aron, Chairman Arcadia Management Council, Division of Forest Environment 260 Arcadia Rd Hope Valley, RI 02832 Please make all checks payable to the State of Rhode Island. Fees can also be collected by or given to a Federation member on the grounds. They will be forwarded to D.F.E. on a regular basis.
- The ring is available by permit for horse events. When no such permit is in force, the ring is available to other horse persons for practice, riding, lunging or attended exercising of horses. **THE RING IS NOT TO BE USED AS A CORRAL/TURNOUT OR HITCHING POST.**
- Do not tie horses to trees. Tie horses to trailer or use rope from tree to tree with a knot at each end. Tie the horses so they can not reach trees. This prevents damage to the bark or roots.
- No galloping through the campsite areas.
Make sure the camp fire is out before leaving.
