
## Woven Angel Ornament




## **MATERIALS**

#2 or #3 Round reed, Cut 4 spokes at 13" long #1 or #2 Round reed, 2 weavers, natural or dyed, 6' Ribbon, Wings, 2' Narrow Ribbon, Tie at neck Raffia, Hair 1" Round Wood Ball with hole, Head Halo, wire or reed circled

- 1. BASE Cut 4 spokes, soak along with 2 pieces of round reed for weavers.
- Choose to work with round reed in your hand, or place flat on table surface. Start with 2 spokes horizontal, place 2 spokes vertically on top of the original 2. With 2 pieces of round reed, begin to twine around the paired spokes as close to intersection as possible. Keep this base flat for 2 rows.
- 3. At beginning of Row 3, begin to separate paired spokes into individual single spokes (splitting groups of 2 into 1). Continue to twine around each spoke at the same time begin to spiral up the sides with a ½" opening between rows of twine. See photo next page.
- 4. Shape the angel ornament with an outward flair for 2 more rows as you upset the sides of the body.
- 5. Re-wet spokes and weavers, continue to weave for a total of approx. 8 rows. At Row 5, begin to decrease the size of the body by pushing in on spokes as you twine. Tug on weavers to enhance decreasing being careful spokes do not slant sideways. Clothespin to keep tension.
- 6. Bring all spokes in together, trim to fit inside the ball head opening at the neck of the angel.
- 7. Glue ends of spokes inside the opening of the ball.
- 8. Glue hair and halo.
- 9. Make wings of 2 feet of ribbon/bow. Tie wings to back with narrow ribbon at neck See photos page 2.

Make wings with 2' ribbon

Tie onto back of angel with narrow ribbon at neck

Add clear thread for hanger
