

Ideas for Chapter Meetings

- Create order: Obligation, Minutes, Old Business, New Business, Closing
- Have an agenda for each chapter meeting for everyone
- Do a team building activity
- Play a meaningful game
- Order Pizza
- Plan for upcoming lodge, district, council, or chapter event
 - District Camporee
 - District Junior Leader Training
 - Fellowship Responsibility
 - Special Needs Camporee Activity
 - Create chapter spirit items (noise makers, hats, shirts, signs, stickers for fellowships, theme related items, spirit chants, totem, buttons to wear on clothing, hats, bandannas, chapter uniform {funny and talented for 'special occasions' }, the list continues)
 - Work on making Roaches, etc...
 - Prepare and delegate Unit Election and Camping Promotion Responsibilities
 - Scout Blast Booth
 - Cub Scout Cross Over Ceremonies
 - Arrow of Light Ceremonies
 - Plan your own district special needs activity (day activity for community)
 - Chapter Camping Trip (just like you do in your troop)
 - Chapter Day Trip (go to a Spring and swim, beach, cook out, etc...)
 - Ask to help out with Tiger Prowl (District Day activity for Tiger Cubs)
 - Assist with Cubscout Pinewood Derby, Car Racing, etc...
- Focus on a chapter service project
- Give out latest news in district and lodge
- Discuss upcoming events and decide what you want to be involved with
- Review the district, council, lodge and chapter calendar at each meeting
- Discuss chapter transportation to and from chapter and lodge events
- Create committees and have committee reports at each meeting
- Ask the lodge officers questions to get more knowledge
- Delegate duties out to fellow officers and committees in your chapter
- Involve your chapter adviser
- Do a spirit yell at your meetings, PRACTICE, PRACTICE, PRACTICE!!
- Come up with chapter goals and create a "PLAN"
- Discuss and listen to everyone about ideas for chapter meetings
- You are the youth and you can make your meetings as fun as you want
- Discuss issues that troops are having (What is a problem in my troop right now)
- Discuss ways to overcome those problems and use your chapter meeting as a counseling session. YOU ARE SCOUTINGS NATIONAL HONOR SOCIETY
- Have mock trial. Create a judge, plaintiff, defendant, etc... and have a scout related court hearing for something pertaining to service, issue on troop level, etc... Have attorneys, witnesses, be creative and talented. Have judge use a gavel.
