

ELECTION CHECK LIST:

ELIGIBILITY:

To be eligible all of the following must be true:

Youth:

- a) Must have unit leader's approval
- b) A male under the age of 21 years
- c) Be First Class as a minimum
- d) Has experienced 15 days and nights of camping, including long term resident camping as defined by his local scout council, approved and under the auspices and standards of the BSA, within 2 years immediately prior to election to candidate status.

Adults registered in troops: (enclosed nomination form to be submitted at time of unit election)

- a) Be currently registered in the unit and that unit must hold an election for youth.
- b) Selection of an adult is based, ability to perform the requisite functions and not for recognition of service, including, current or prior achievement and position.
- c) The individual will be an asset to the lodge to the demonstrated skills and abilities which fulfill the purpose of the Order.
- d) The camping requirements set forth for youth are fulfilled.
- e) The adult leader will provide a positive role model for the growth and development of the youth members of the lodge.
- f) Be 21 years of age or older

CHECK LIST:

1. Have election request from unit Leader with troop data.
2. Confirm election with unit leader.
3. Assign election team and alternate member.
4. Arrive early and check arrangements.
5. Verify that 50% of active troop members are present.
6. Materials needed:
 - Video, VCR, and TV Ballots and pencils
 - Election report form (youth)
 - Adult candidate recommendation
7. Camp promotion requested:
 - Lodge Camp Promotion Video, VCR & TV, and extension cord.
8. Challenge Ordeal members to prepare for Brotherhood.
