

Boxwell Summer Camp
July 3-9 2011

Sunday, Jul 3rd : We will meet at BP Exit 11 at 12:00 PM. **COST OF CAMP IS \$205 or (\$185 if received by 4 Apr 10)**

Once arriving at Boxwell we will set up camp and then proceed to the swimming pool for swimming tests. The swimming test follows:

SWIMMER's TEST:

Jump feet first into water over your head in depth, level off and begin swimming. Swim 75 yards in a strong manner using one or more of the following strokes: side stroke, breast stroke, trudge or crawl; then swim 25 yards using an easy resting back stroke. The 100 yards must be swim continuously and include at least one sharp turn. After completing the swim, rest by floating. **REMEMBER:** This is NOT a race. Take as long as you need to in order to complete the swim test. Instructors from Boxwell will be right there to watch over and guide the kids the entire time.

Friday, July 8th: Parents evening...parents should arrive by 4 pm....after packing up and cleaning up the site we will enjoy an evening of food and campfire.

Suggested packing list

Mosquito net	Scout shirt with a hanger
Under bed Rubbermaid container	Pencil/pen and a notebook
Scout Handbook with pencil and paper(in plastic bag)	Flashlight and extra batteries
Sleeping bag, blankets, pillow and twin fitted sheet	Long pants and sweatshirt/jacket
Poncho or raincoat	2 towels and washcloth
2 – 3 swim suits (they spend a lot of time in these)	6 pairs of socks (at least)
2 pairs of shoes (no open toed shoes)	1 pair of shower shoes
5 pairs of shorts	6 T-shirts
At least 6 pairs of underwear	Insect repellent
Water bottle/canteen	Sun block

Soap, toothbrush, toothpaste, comb, deodorant, baby powder, shampoo- (I suggest putting these items into a mesh bag to make it easy to keep up with and take to the shower). Some spending money for shooting on free-time and/or for the Trading post (\$20) plus \$10 for Boxwell T-shirt. Battery operated fans help the kids stay cool in the heat. **NO OPEN TOED SHOES(CROCKS/FLIPFLOPS/SANDALS). Closed Toed Shoes ONLY in CAMP.**
Suggest a long flat tote to place under the bunk to keep all the items nice and neat.
