- Depart from Max Bowl North on Tuesday, June 24th at 11:00 p.m. and return to Max Bowl North on Monday, June 30th between 9-10:00 p.m.

- Cost per bowler = \$528.50 (*estimated cost)...includes bus, hotel, and tournament fees, bowling practice, bus snacks & pizza party.**

*This cost is based upon the number of participants that indicated they would be riding the bus to Omaha. It is very important that you let us know ASAP if you are not going to Omaha on the bus. To help this trip be cost effective we need between 33-35 bowlers. At this time we have 39 interested bowlers. Our maximum number is 35 – what does this mean to you...if you don't get your deposit in on time you could loose your spot on the bus. It is very important to let you all know in advance...if we get requests from bowlers to remove their name from the bus list this **cost will increase** and if there are too many "drop-offs" this trip will more than likely be cancelled. **Remember the more bowlers we have riding the bus the cheaper the trip would be.***

- Attached are forms we need completed by you or your parent ASAP. We would very much appreciate you bringing these completed forms along with your **\$100 "save your seat" deposit** to the Armadilla II travel league stop on January 20th.
- Tournament Fees of \$105.50 (which includes 3 team events, 2 dbl/sgl events and side Scholarship Tournament) is included in the cost per bowler and are **due in full by March 30th**. Although this amount is included in the initial cost for the trip this amount must be paid in full before we can register our bowlers. Bowlers participating in the Scholarship Tournament must be entering the 9th grade as of August 2008.
- Cost per non-bowling adult chaperone = \$413.00
- Food, souvenirs & other activities outside of bowling are not included in the initial cost per person. Only you know best how much to send for food & souvenirs. However, we do suggest no less than \$25 per day.

- Activities beyond bowling are still being considered. Other activities and information regarding associated costs will be forwarded to you at a later date.
- All bowlers **under the age of 13** must be accompanied by an adult parent/guardian.

The following **mandatory** payment schedule has been set-up...

- January 20th ...\$100 - “save your seat” Non-refundable deposit.
- February 17th ...\$55 payment
- March 2nd ...\$55 payment
- March 30th ...\$105.50 bowling entry fees are due! If you will not be participating in the scholarship portion of the tournament your entry fees will be \$70.50
No turn back date...there are no refunds of any sort after this date.
- April 6th...\$55 payment
- April 20th ...\$55 payment
- May 4th ...\$55 payment
- May 18th...\$48.00
- May 31st ...any balance you may have outstanding. Your trip must be paid for in full by the end of May. Please know that any unpaid balance beyond this date will result in your name being removed from the bus list, team listings and any paid monies being forfeited.

If you are not able to pay the suggested amounts, please pay something either weekly or monthly...it is a lot easier to make several small payments as opposed to one large payment. Not only does this help you, but we will need to pay required deposits for the bus and hotels in advance and if we don't have the funds to meet our obligations we will be forced to cancel the trip.

Most of the payment schedule dates are either a travel league or tournament date.
