“Together We Can”

The National PTA reflections program is an arts recognition and achievement program for students. The Reflections Program provides opportunities for students to express themselves creatively and to receive positive recognition for original works of art inspired by a pre-selected theme, while increasing community awareness on the importance of the arts in education. Although the program follows a “contest” format, winning should not be the emphasis.

Students may submit an entry in any of the six arts areas listed below. Only original works of art are accepted. The students’ works are critiqued against others in the same grade division. The six arts areas are as follows:

Literature

Musical composition

Photography

Visual Arts

Dance Choreography

Film/Video Production

Guidelines:

- All entries submitted must be original works and must relate to the theme “Together We Can”.*
- Deadline for submission is Tuesday November 9th by end of school day. Dance submissions will be evaluated after school on Tuesday November 9th.*

- *Submissions should be left in the KMS library along with the completed Student Entry form and Parent Guardian consent forms (attached). Do not leave entries any earlier than November 9th as we do not have a secure location for them before that time.*
- *Students will be notified of results by Friday November 12th. Winners will then have their submissions go on to the Council level Wednesday December 1st at the KISD Administration building.*
