

NATIONAL ASSOCIATION OF LEASE AND TITLE ANALYSTS

SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION GUIDELINES

A. Applicants

1. National Association of Lease and Title Analysts (NALTA) members currently employed in the Energy Industry.
2. Students who have obtained a minimum of ninety (90) credit hours in a fully accredited college or university.

B. Scholarship Priorities

1. A NALTA member who is currently employed in the Energy Industry and attending school part time to complete an industry related degree will be given first priority.
2. A child or relative of a current member of NALTA who is an Energy Management (EM) major and/or a Petroleum Land Management (PLM) major currently enrolled full-time in a fully accredited EM/PLM program at a college or university.
3. An EM/PLM major who is not a child or relative of a current member of NALTA, but is currently enrolled full-time in a fully accredited EM/PLM program at a college or university.
4. Students must have a grade point average overall of 2.5 or greater to be considered.
5. **Only applications submitted with certified copy of latest college transcripts will be considered.**

C. Miscellaneous

1. The NALTA Board shall not be obligated to award any scholarship during any fiscal year.
2. Applications for scholarships will be accepted from January 1st through March 31st. However, applications may be considered at any time throughout the year.
3. Scholarships granted by the Scholarship Committee will be paid directly to the educational institution. Scholarship payments shall be awarded once the Committee receives satisfactory proof that the recipient is enrolled in a fully accredited college or university. At the sole discretion of the Scholarship Committee, the scholarship may also be paid directly to the student.
4. NALTA may desire to have Scholarship winners receive their award at its national conference held in September or October of each year. If approved by the Board of Directors of NALTA, at NALTA's expense the Scholarship winners will be flown to the conference city, enrolled in the conference, and provided two nights accommodations at the conference hotel.
5. All Scholarship applications should be sent to the Scholarship committee at the address shown on the Application Form.
6. All NALTA Scholarship guidelines must be approved by the NALTA Board of Directors and are subject to change at any time.
