VISITATION RULES 2006-2007

DISTRICT 24-C LIONS, LIONESSE-LIONS AND LIONESSE CLUBS

1. The District 24-C Visitation Program runs from **July 1, 2006 through June 30, 2007**
2. Please use the official form and mail it to the District Chairman by the 10th of the month following the visitation.
3. For the purpose of visitation, Lions, and Lioness Clubs are divided into three classes:
 - a. Class A: Clubs with 30 or less active members; at least 1 member must visit Class A clubs must visit 9 clubs - including at least 5 in their own region.
 - b. Class B: Clubs with 31- 55 active members; at least 2 members must visit. Class B clubs must visit 14 clubs - including at least 7 in their own region.
 - c. Class C: Clubs with more than 55 active members; at least 3 members must visit. Class C Clubs must visit 18 clubs - including at least 9 in their own region.
4. Points are awarded as follows:
 - a. A visit to another club earns 5 points plus a mileage factor.
 - b. An out-of state visit earns 10 points plus a mileage factor.
 - c. Visits to Fall Conferences, Mid-Winter Conferences, other District Conferences, State Conventions, International Conventions, USA/Canada Forums, Pin Trader Conventions, Eyeglass Recycling Centers, Lions Schools, Zone Meetings (if outside your own zone), Bland Contests, International Headquarters, and Cruises (if meeting attended), Projects involving Lions (such as RAM), earn 10 points plus a mileage factor.
 - d. A zone meeting (within a club's own zone) counts as a visit to the host club, or 5 points plus a mileage factor.
5. The mileage factor is based on travel distance both ways multiplied by .05 (maximum 200 miles).

SPECIAL NOTES:

1. Any club that sends delegates, regardless of number, to Multiple District 24's State Convention or an International Convention or Forum may claim a visit.
2. A club that sends any member(s) to work as SAHMSU technicians or screeners for another club (at the request of that club) will earn 10 points plus the mileage factor.
3. A Class B or Class C club member who travels more than 200 miles to visit another club in 24-C may claim a visit.
4. A Governor's Award will be presented to each Lion or Lion-Lioness Club that completes visits in accordance with rule 3 above.
5. There will also be 3 special Class Individual Awards for the Lion or Lioness in each class who visits the most clubs. Only club visits count in this category.

REMEMBER:

If Lion or Lioness Club members visit a joint meeting of 2 or more clubs, it can only be counted as a visit to one club.

Official visits will not be accepted as Visitations
