Details: Annual hike up Spruce Mountain will consist of meeting at base of the hiking trail. While we wait for everyone to gather, we will practice Leave No trace and clean up the waiting area of all trash. Once everyone is gathered, we will proceed along the hiking trail which will consist of grass, dirt, tree roots, and some lightly rocky terrain.

It is about a 2.2 mile hike to the top with gradual elevation changes up until mid-way, then a little steeper toward the top. It should take about 2 hours for the ascent – with a total of 4 hours for the hike up and down.

We will take a stop at the top and eat our lunch; enjoy the view and climb the fire tower for those that wish to climb it! ***DON'T FORGET TO BRING YOUR CAMERA!***

Suggestions: Wear good hiking boots, dress in layers, bring along a backpack for lunch & snacks, and raingear.
