Do you know where the athlete was from that won more Olympic medals than Michael Phelps? Do you know where the tallest chimney in the world is located? Do you know which country is known as a chess superpower?



Would you and your family like to learn more about culture from Eastern Europe, Russia and Central Asia? If so, the Washington FRUA INC Heritage Camp Weekend is the place for you. Families will get a chance to relax, make friends, participate in camp activities and learn more about Eastern Europe, Russia and Central Asia countries and their culture. Please join us for the Washington FRUA INC Heritage Camp at Camp Lakeview in Graham, Washington.

- ***The camp will include cultural aspects from every FRUA INC country from which we have children in attendance at the Heritage Camp.***

## **CAMP ACTIVITIES:**

The entire family can join in on all of the fun that heritage camp has to offer. Just a few of the many exciting activities that we plan to include:

- Friday Night Dinner – bring a potluck item and contribution to our “Stone Soup”
- ***The children will be divided into groups by age for these activities.:***
  - Cultural classes
  - Cultural craft projects
  - Games from various FRUA INC regions
  - Cultural music and dancing
  - Folktales
  - Physical activities for our energetic kids
  - There will also be a parent/child group for younger kids as young as two.
- Campfire program with S’mores
- Parents classes, including culture class
- 5 meals included in fees, including a delicious variety of ethnic and familiar foods.



## **LODGING**

The retreat center at Camp Lakeview in Graham, Washington has been reserved for the exclusive use of this heritage camp for the weekend. Additionally, the cottages in the campground area have been reserved for camp participants this year, too.



Families can choose either small private rooms or a shared cabin or cottages (shared or private).

- **Retreat Center Lodge Rooms:** These are small private rooms that have four single beds (2 sets of bunk beds). The rooms are small, but there is just enough room for one port-a-crib or one sleeping mat in the rooms, if needed. Restrooms with showers are shared among families. These rooms can be reserved by groups of three or more people.
- **Retreat Center Cabins:** The cabins next to the lodge are ideal for families who want to stay together as a group. Each cabin has one large shared sleeping room that sleeps 4-7 (4-5 single bunks plus a double), a smaller bedroom that sleeps 4 (1 set of single bunks and one double bed), and a restroom with a shower.
- **Cottages:** The cottages are in the campground area and sleep 5 to 9 people. They each have a living room, a bathroom, a kitchen or kitchenette, and one bedroom. It is a 5 minute walk from the cottages to the retreat center where the camp activities are held. These can be requested by groups of five people or more. There is a \$60 upgrade fee per cottage/per group to reserve a cottage for the weekend. If we have less than 75% occupancy of the Retreat Center, we will cancel cottages and move families' who have requested Cottages to Retreat Center lodging. Any collected upgrade fees will be refunded.
- **Families that want to share a cabin/cottage or have private rooms by each other need to be sure that they register at the same time. Please be very specific on your registration forms.**

## **NON-REFUNDABLE DEPOSIT:**

Every attendee age two and over is required to pay a **\$25 per person** non-refundable deposit to cover expenses for facilities rentals and other expenses for the weekend's activities.

## **NON-MEMBER FEE:**

Families that **are not** current members of **FRUA INC** will need to pay for a one-year family FRUA membership. The \$35 membership dues can be paid on-line.: <http://frua.org/become-a-member>.

## **PAYMENT & REFUNDS:**

The non-refundable deposit is due immediately to reserve your spot. Full payment is due by April 30, 2012 as outlined in the attached registration form. Please make the check payable to **FRUA INC** **or pay via PayPal**. If for some reason you need to cancel your reservations, we will refund your payment less the non-refundable deposit up until **May 31, 2012**. Camp will fill up fast, so it is important to register as soon as possible. Registration after April 30, 2012 (with \$20 per person higher fee) will only be possible if there are still openings.

## **HERITAGE CAMP IS A VOLUNTEER-RUN EVENT:**

This event is organized and operated solely by volunteers. During the actual event, every attending family will be assigned to help with meals, classes, or activities and clean up. Your participation in these responsibilities is essential for the success of the camp. Thank you very much for your understanding.

***Please note that the heritage camp is not a fund raising activity. The fees go to cover costs only.***
