**Marlene Rice** update: It's been almost a month since Marlene had heart valve replacement. She was not a candidate for the minimally invasive operation, so her recovery time will be a little longer. They replaced two of her valves with mechanical valves. She was at Swedish Heart Institute for one week. Marlene said she is doing fine and has been able to start walks depending on the weather. Eldon has been a great help and is even doing the cooking. She says thanks for the cards.

**LuciBelle O'Grady** saw the doctor on April 1 and possibly may have her "constant companion" for the last two months removed from her leg. The "wound vacuum" on her leg was developed for the first Iraq war. It is mounted to her walker and attached to her leg. After removal of it she will be in the hospital for a day to close up the wound, then an external leg vacuum put on for a week or so. She has appreciated the cards and phone calls and will be very happy to have it all over with.
