As your new treasurer I wanted to update the membership on a few changes that have been made. Our financial information will all be kept on Quicken and to date all of 2008 has been input. At the November board meeting a motion was made, seconded and passed that the hourly rental be increased from \$50 an hour to \$60 an hour. The final review of our 2009 budget will be done at the February 25th board meeting and with the additional rental income the projected revenues for the Kenmore Community Club should put us in the black.

At the January 28th board meeting a motion was made, seconded and passed that all damage deposits be kept in a separate account and that is in the process of being set up.
