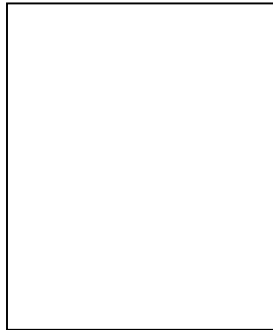

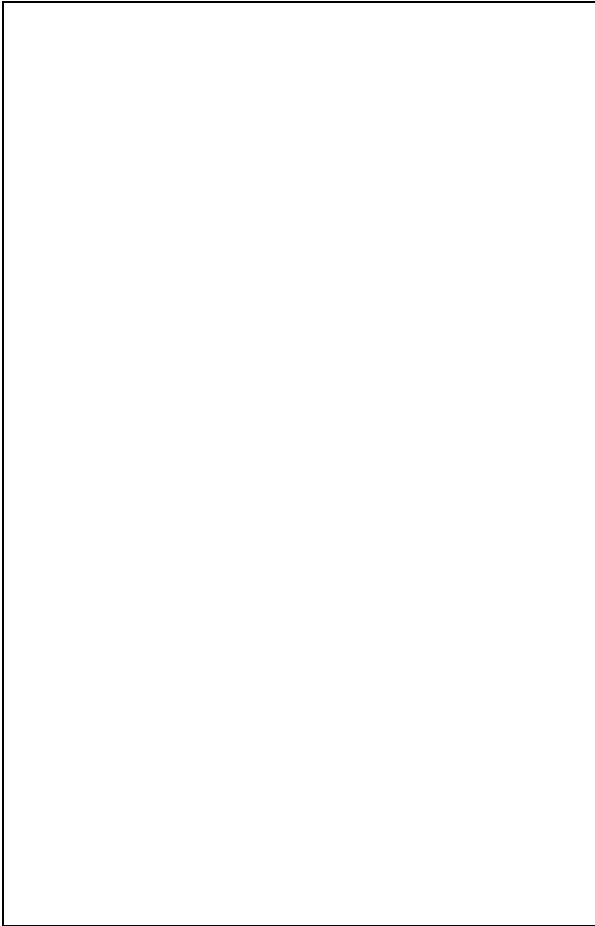

In accordance with City of Renton Ordinance No. 4752

1. Permit must be displayed at all times business is conducted.
2. Permits are valid only for the person and business issued to, and are non-transferable.
3. Peddling is NOT allowed between the hours of 8:00 p.m. and 8:00 a.m.
4. All peddlers shall notify the Finance Dept. at least two business hours before any peddling activities are to be conducted.
5. No peddler shall have any exclusive right to any location in public streets, is not permitted a stationary location, nor permitted to operate in any congested area where operations might impede or inconvenience the public. The judgment of a police officer, exercised in good faith, shall be conclusive as to whether the area is congested or the public impeded or inconvenienced.
6. This permit may be revoked for any of the follow causes: fraud or misrepresentation, false statements on the application, violations of City Ordinances and conviction after submission of a felony or misdemeanor directly related to the occupation of peddler.
