

Pre-Bowling Rules

Because we encourage our youth bowlers to participate in other sports and events, all of our youth leagues allow pre-bowling. You may pre-bowl for any future week(s) where you are not able to bowl on the scheduled league date. We will use those scores for the date you will miss.

There are some rules that must be followed:

1. In order to make pre-bowling fair for all, specific times will be set aside for pre-bowling where lanes will be conditioned the same as they are for those who bowl at our regularly scheduled league times.
2. Pre-bowling will be supervised by a coach or other authorized adult. You must get a “Falls Youth League” pre-bowl form from the supervisor and pay your weekly bowling fee in order to pre-bowl. **If you know ahead of time that you will be pre-bowling for a future week, you may pre-pay for that week or weeks ahead of time in your weekly envelope. If you come in to pre-bowl, you must pay if you haven’t already pre-paid. NO MONEY = NO PRE-BOWLING.**
3. Fill out the pre-bowl form, **with the date you are pre-bowling for**, write down your scores, and mark which league you are in.
4. Turn the pre-bowl form in to the supervisor when you finish, and we will write your scores on the recap for the week you are pre-bowling for.
5. You may pre-bowl for more than one week during your pre-bowling session if time permits.
6. **There will be no pre-bowling on Friday evenings after 7:00pm.**
7. **Current pre-bowling days and times are; Mondays 4:30pm – 6:00pm (Starting September 28th), Thursdays 4:00pm – 6:00pm, Fridays 4:00pm – 7:00pm, and Saturdays 11:30am – 1:30pm**
 - **Pre-bowling days and times are subject to change (we could add days or extend times based on lane availability)**

IMPORTANT

Any score changes made are indicated on the printout we get when you are finished bowling. If the automatic scoring system is making errors, the supervisor must be notified while you are bowling so it can be noted on the pre-bowl form. Games with excessive score corrections will not be counted unless it is noted that the automatic scorer was malfunctioning. **In other words, CHEATING WILL NOT BE ALLOWED.** Anyone found cheating would no longer have the option of pre-bowling.

Once you receive a pre-bowl form and are assigned a pair of lanes, your scores count for league whether you bowl good or bad, finish bowling or not.

Pre-bowling cannot be changed to “just practice”.
