

Pre-Bowling Rules

Because we encourage our youth bowlers to participate in other sports and events, all of our youth leagues allow pre-bowling. You may pre-bowl for any future week(s) where you are not able to bowl on the scheduled league date. We'll use those scores for the date(s) you'll miss.

There are some rules that must be followed:

1. You must get a "Falls Youth League" pre-bowl form from the counter and pay your weekly bowling fee in order to pre-bowl. **Make sure the counter person writes down the amount you paid on your pre-bowl form. If you know ahead of time that you'll be pre-bowling for a future week, you may pre-pay for that week or weeks ahead of time in your weekly envelope. If you come in to pre-bowl, you must pay if you haven't pre-paid. NO MONEY = NO PRE-BOWLING.**
2. Fill out the pre-bowl form, **with the date you're pre-bowling for**, write down your scores, and mark which league you are in.
3. Turn the pre-bowl form in at the counter when you finish, and we'll write your scores on the recap for the week you're pre-bowling for.
4. You may pre-bowl for more than one week during your pre-bowling session if time permits.
5. **Current pre-bowling days and times are;**
 - **Sundays – All day (may be limited by tournaments or group outings)**
 - **Mondays – 3:00pm – 5:00pm, 9:00pm – Close**
 - **Tuesdays – Reservations only**
 - **Wednesdays – No pre-bowling**
 - **Thursdays – 3:00pm – 5:00pm, 9:00pm – Close**
 - **Fridays – 3:00pm – 5:00pm, 9:00pm – 11:00pm**
 - **Saturdays – Reservations only**
 - **Pre-bowling days and times are subject to change, check the website for most current**
 - **You must be finished bowling by 5:00pm on Monday, Thursday, and Friday**
 - **Call Classic for lane availability (262) 255-2695**

IMPORTANT

Any score changes made are indicated on the printout we get when you're finished bowling. If the automatic scoring system is making errors, the counter person must be notified while you're bowling so it can be noted on the pre-bowl form. Games with excessive score corrections will not be counted unless it is noted that the automatic scorer was malfunctioning. **In other words, CHEATING WILL NOT BE ALLOWED.** Anyone found cheating (changing scores) would no longer have the option of pre-bowling.

Once you receive a pre-bowl form and are assigned a pair of lanes, your scores count for league whether you bowl good or bad, finish bowling or not.

Pre-bowling cannot be changed to "just practice"
