Sport Bowling Condition

Tournament Rules (Tier 1 Rules Apply)

- 1) Tournament is certified by USBC, and is open to all full time enrolled college students who are USBC members and are also eligible under USBC Collegiate guidelines. All participants must be USBC Intercollegiate members or pay a \$25.00 non-member participation fee.
- 2) Entries from multiple five-person teams representing the same institution can only be accepted 20 days prior to the start of the event providing space is available.
- 3) If an institution has multiple five-person teams competing, only the highest finishing team representing that institution shall earn tournament awards.
- 4) Student-athletes are limited to use a maximum of five (5) bowling balls in Tier 1 competition. See Rule E in Collegiate Handbook.
- 5) Qualifying will consist of nine (9) conventional games and ten (10) Baker games.
- 6) Tournament entries close at 10:00 am on Saturday, October 3rd, 2009 unless the field is filled prior to that time. A full field would consist of 72 teams. Projected scholarships are based on 40 men's teams and 24 women's teams.
- 7) Separate divisions for men and women. All competition on a scratch basis.
- 8) Team rosters are limited to eight (8) players. Teams must bowl with five (5) players on a team. Teams bowling with less than 5 players will receive a score of zero for each missing bowler.
- 9) Mixed Teams – men and women competing on a mixed team shall be included in the men's all-events standings for the tournament.
- 10) Substitutes are permitted. Once a player has been removed from a game the player must remain out for the remainder of the game. However, they may return in the next game. Score is credited to starting bowler. Only three (3) substitutions may be made during any game. In the case of a school having multiple teams, a substitute may bowl on the roster on which they are listed at the time of entry.
- 11) All award fees will be returned 100% on a ratio of 1 in 3.
- 12) Bowlers are to be properly attired. Each school is recommended to wear matching shirts with a collar.
