# What is MAP?

---

- MAP - Measures of Academic Progress
- Achievement tests (Math, Reading, Language, Science)
- Delivered by computer
- Teacher have access to results within 24 hours

## How does MAP work?

---

- Questions appear on a students computer screen.
- Use the mouse or keyboard to answer questions.
- Test will adjust based on how students answer the question.
- It will build a test just for the learner.

## Why take MAP tests?

---

- To find out exactly where students are currently performing.
- To help our teachers know what students should be working on to improve.
- Identification of the lower and higher performing students so that appropriate resources are used to meet individual student needs.

# Numbers

---

- There are currently 157 partners in Wisconsin.
- Over 1200 partner in the US (2003).
- Over 3 million tests administered (2003).
- Currently approximately 24 million tests administered.
