TOURNAMENT RULES

1. Entry is open to all members of the WS USBC WBA who are 55 years of age or older on or prior to September 30, 2011. Entrant need not belong to a Senior league to be eligible. Associate card available for \$10.00 USBC, \$1.00 State plus local dues of entrants local association. When the local and state dues are not known, adult associate dues will be \$21.00 (\$10.00 national, \$10.00 local and \$1.00 state).
 - a. Advance reservations open March 16, 2011.
 - b. Entries and full fees for reservations made March 16 through September 10, 2011, are due by September 15, 2011.
 - c. Entries and full fees for reservations made after Sept 10, 2011 must be received no later than one week prior to bowling date reserved.
 - d. After start of tournament, walk-ins will be accepted based on lane availability. Please call (920) 406-2695 or toll free (800) 660-9655, Monday through Friday, 8 a.m. to 4:30 p.m. for availability. Entry and payment due at check-in.

2. Tournament will consist of a doubles event, singles event and optional all events. Singles event will follow doubles event. Handicap will be 95 % of 235. Singles competition will be separate divisions for each of the five age classifications as follows: Division "1" 75 and older, Division "2" 70 – 74, Division "3" 65 – 69, Division "4" 60 – 64, Division "5" 55 – 59. There will be only one division in the doubles event and doubles partners need not be in the same division or age bracket.
3. All WS USBC WBA Senior participants may substitute in Doubles Event in addition to bowling on a regular entry. Entrants will be allowed to bowl only once in Singles Event. **ALL EVENTS SCORE WILL BE DETERMINED BY USING FIRST DOUBLES SCORE BOWLED.**
4. Entries must be accompanied by full amount of fees. Bowlers wishing to bowl together must send entries together. No fees refunded after September 29, 2011.
5. Entrants shall use their highest 2010-11 season USBC certified league average of at least 21 games.
 - If no 2010-11 summer or winter average, entrant shall use the 2009 - 10 (previous year) winter average of at least 21 games.
 - If no previous winter or summer league average has been established, entrant shall use their 2011-12 certified league average as of the time of bowling, provided they have bowled at least 12 games and verification form is provided..
 - If none of the above apply, entrant shall use the scratch figure of 235.
6. USBC Rule #319a, #2 (10 pin increase provision) and Rule #319e will be waived. Rule #319D (prize winnings need not be reported) will be waived.
7. **IT SHALL BE EACH ENTRANT'S RESPONSIBILITY TO VERIFY THE ACCURACY OF HER AGE AND AVERAGE.** Failure to use correct age will result in disqualification. Failure to use the correct average shall disqualify score if submitted average is lower than correct average, thereby resulting in more handicap. Prize winnings will be based on the submitted average if it is higher than correct average.
8. All entrants must report 45 minutes before scheduled time of bowling for lane assignments.
9. All prize money will be returned 100% on a ratio of at least one prize for every five entries, with distribution to be made within 30 days after the completion of the tournament. In the event of ties, prize money will be divided equally. Duplicate awards will be given for first place ties.
10. All Events winners in each division are eligible to participate in the USBC National Senior Tournament. WS USBC WBA will pay participation fee.
11. If the State Champion from any division declines to attend the National event, the WS USBC WBA will have the option of sending the second place finisher from that division.
12. The Tournament Committee will rule on anything not covered by these rules or USBC Tournament Rules.

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
