

WISCONSIN WOMEN'S BOWLING ASSOCIATION SCHOLARSHIP

Eligibility, Instructions and Selection Procedure

Instructions to Applicant – please be sure entire application is legible.

Eligibility: (Please read entire application carefully)

All graduating High School seniors are eligible to receive a scholarship, provided the student meets the following requirements:

- A. Must be a graduating High School senior planning to attend an accredited secondary learning institution. (Secondary schools include public or private university, junior or state college, technical institute or any specialized trade school.)
- B. Must file an application furnished by the Wisconsin Women's Bowling Association Scholarship Committee, with complete information by the **March 1st Deadline** in the year of graduation. Application to be filed with the Wisconsin State USBC Women's Bowling Association at the address below.
- C. Has unimpaired amateur standing in all athletics.
- D. Is a member of a league certified by the United States Bowling Congress within the boundaries of the Wisconsin State USBC Women's Bowling Association and is in good standing for the current season.
- E. Has a 2.0 or better grade point average at the close of Semester 1 of applicant's senior year. For scholarship purposes GPA will be based on 4.0 system (e.g. A-4.0, B-3.0, C-2.0).

Instructions:

Step #1 - Part I, fill out entirely. Be sure to sign application.

Step #2 - Part II, compose an essay of at least 150 words telling of your specific college choice, future plans and how bowling activities will help you to achieve your goals. Essay must be typewritten.

Step #3 - Part III, have a local Youth Official/Coach fill out part III entirely.

Step #4 - Part IV, have a current High School official or your school counselor fill out part IV.

Step #5 - Mail the application and the essay to the address below by the **March 1ST Deadline**.

Selection procedure:

Applications will be graded by the Wisconsin State Women's Bowling Association Scholarship Committee using a predetermined point system. Essays will be graded by an independent group of educators. Essays are graded on content, grammar and spelling. The essay score may represent up to 40% of total score. The application and essay scores will be combined and the highest scoring applicants will be selected to receive scholarships. The scholarship amounts and number of scholarships issued is predetermined by the Wisconsin State USBC Women's Bowling Association Board of Directors.
