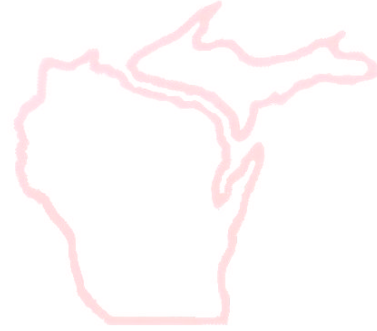

### HOW TO SUBMIT NOMINATIONS FOR WWBA HALL OF FAME

If you are interested in submitting the name of a candidate for the WS USBC WBA Hall of Fame, please complete the attached nomination form and return it no later than August 1 to:

A WS USBC WBA member may submit nominations in either of the two categories-Superior Performance or Meritorious Service. Nominees may be from your own local bowling association or any other local bowling association in the WS USBC WBA. Nominations are received by the WS USBC WBA Hall of Fame selection committee and final selections are made.

For Meritorious Service nominations, please include as much information as possible concerning the nominee's contributions to WWBA/WS USBC WBA (state) service. Consideration for nomination is evaluated with an emphasis on contributions in service to WWBA/WS USBC WBA.

A WS USBC WBA board member shall not be eligible for consideration to the Meritorious category of the Hall of Fame while she is serving on the board.

Information submitted for persons not selected will be kept in the committee's active file for 5 years. This means nominees will automatically be reconsidered annually and it will not be necessary to submit new nomination forms annually. It will be the responsibility of the nominator to provide WS USBC WBA with any additional information on a yearly basis.

Basic qualifications are listed on the reverse side of this form.

## **PURPOSE OF THE WS USBC WBA HALL OF FAME**

### **SUPERIOR PERFORMANCE QUALIFICATIONS**

The purpose of the Hall of Fame shall be to recognize and perpetuate the names of those WWBA/WS USBC WBA members who have achieved outstanding performance in the game of American Tenpins.

1. This award shall be given to a present or past member for outstanding bowling performance while a member of WWBA/WS USBC WBA. She shall have been a member of WWBA/WS USBC WBA for at least 15 years and participated in 10 state tournaments, not necessarily continuous.
2. Nominee shall have won a Badger Queens Open Championship and/or a WWBA/WS USBC WBA Championship in team, doubles, singles or all events.
3. Have at least 4 of the following in certified competition.
  - a) An average of 185 or more for a minimum of 5 years.
  - b) A Senior Championship.
  - c) A WIBC/USBC championship in team, doubles, singles and/or all events.
  - d) A local association championship in team, doubles, singles and/or all events.
  - e) Other sanctioned tournaments / accomplishments.
  - f) Special bowling contributions and honors.
4. No stipulation as to age.

### **MERITORIOUS SERVICE QUALIFICATIONS**

The purpose of the Hall of Fame shall be to perpetuate the names of those WWBA/WS USBC WBA members who have contributed through Meritorious Service to the game of American Tenpins.

1. This award shall be given to a present or past WWBA/WS USBC WBA member for meritorious service. She shall have been a member for at least 15 years, not necessarily continuous.
2. A nominee must have at least 5 of the following qualifications:
  - a) Served as an officer or director of the state association.
  - b) Served as a chairman of a committee of the state association.
  - c) Served on a committee of the state association.
  - d) Served as a state delegate.
  - e) Supported WWBA/WS USBC WBA activities @ workshop coordinator, annual meeting coordinator, etc.
  - f) Served as a WIBC/USBC delegate.
  - g) Served in some capacity in any WWBA/WS USBC WBA state tournament @ group leader, committee chair, hostess coordinator, etc.
  - h) Served as a WIBC/USBC officer, director or committee member.
  - i) Served with BVL, WJBA\WSYBA, AJBA\YABA, Bowling Council, Membership Development, 600 Club, 500 Club, Wisconsin Women Bowling Writers or other bowling related organization.
3. Nominee shall have made outstanding contributions to the good and welfare of the game of tenpins through administrative or organization work in WWBA/WS USBC WBA.

No stipulations as to age.
