

Following are the required to host:

GUIDELINES

1.
 - a. "1" house tournament with 48 available lanes minimum requirement.
 - b. "2" house tournament with not less than one 24 lane house for a combined total of 56 or more lanes will be accepted.
 - c. Tournament runs from first weekend in February through the end of April, unless extended. Three 3 shifts on Saturday & Sunday with optional 4th shift on Saturday.
 - d. **ALL LANES MUST BE AVAILABLE for all dates and times of the tournament-- Excluding Easter.**
 - e. Invitation must include available dates, automatic scoring, cost of bowling including the use of shoes, tax and score processing print outs. Any other information will be helpful to the tournament site committee.
 - f. The local association shall determine the center(s) to be used in their invitation.
2. **The Host Association and Proprietors will secure with their Convention Bureau a \$1.00 per child donation to be used to support the Wisconsin State USBC Youth Association Scholarship Fund.**
3. Adequate room to be provided for office use, check-in and auditors.
4. Scoring system: Automatic/Telescore/Other: *(If considering a change in score marking)*, please include price for both regular and automatic.
5.
 - a. Space provided for high score posting for all classes plus Doubles & Singles.
 - b. Space provided for approved saleable items.
6.
 - a. Invitations for hosting the State Tournament shall be sent to the Wisconsin State Association Manager postmarked by October 15th by Certified Mail with a return receipt requested.
 - b. Tournament sites are selected by the Delegates three years in advance.
 - c. The local association will be expected to fill the opening squad and reservations must be received October 15.
7. The local association shall submit names to be considered for site director(s).
8. The bowling center agrees that No smoking and/or consumption of alcoholic beverages will be allowed in the settee and concourse area. A designated area may be allowed away from the bowlers.
9. The bowling center agrees to carry and pay the premiums for public liability insurance (including liability under the safe place statute) insuring manager and Wisconsin State USBC Youth Association against injury to property for at least \$100,000.00 and against injury to person or loss of life arising out of the use or occupancy of the premises, with limits of \$1,000,000.00 for one person and \$2,000,000.00 for any number of persons injured or killed in any one accident, and shall provide Wisconsin State USBC Youth Association with a certificate of the existence of such insurance executed by the manager's insurance carrier which shall be subject to Wisconsin State

USBC Youth Association's approval for adequacy of protection. Said certificate shall firmly obligate the carrying company to give Wisconsin State USBC Youth Association written notice 10 days in advance of any reduction in the amounts of coverage or cancellation of the policy. The Wisconsin State USBC Youth Association shall be included as an additional insured.
