

Keith Ray Lisonbee, Jan. 22, 2012

GREEN RIVER -- Keith Ray Lisonbee, 68, of Green River, died Sunday, Jan. 22, 2012 at Memorial Hospital of Sweetwater County, Rock Springs, following a lengthy illness.

He had been a resident of Green River for the past 21 years. Keith was born Dec. 7, 1943 in Roosevelt, Utah the son of Roy R. Lisonbee and Bernice Mabel Jackson Lisonbee.

He graduated from Granger High School in Granger, Utah with the class of 1962.

Keith served an LDS mission to Berlin and then was transferred to the Eastern States Mission in 1963. He married the former Judy Hess of Deweyville, Utah in 1968.

Lisonbee was employed in the electric utility industries from 1965 until his retirement from the Jim Bridger Plant in 1997. Prior to moving to Wyoming in 1990, he lived in Wellington, Utah, working at the Hunter Plant as plant training coordinator.
